

St. Colman's Parish Second Sunday of Advent 4th /5th December 2021

"Make ready the way of the Lord."

A blizzard hit the Kansas prairie. Two feet of snow drifted to five and six feet in places. The telephone rang in the doctor's home. The time had come for John Lang's wife to have her baby. But it was impossible for the doctor to get through those drifts. John Lang called his neighbours: Can you help the doc to get through? In no time, from all directions, came men and boys with ploughs and shovels. They laboured with all their might almost for two hours until finally the old doc was able to make it, just in time to deliver the Lang boy.

Today, to all of us comes a call from another Father, God the Father through His prophet Isaiah and repeated by Jesus' own cousin John the Baptist: "Make ready the way of the Lord." But we are called, not to remove piles of snow, but piles of sin, neglect, thoughtlessness, the things that make it difficult and often impossible for the Divine Child to be reborn to our hearts and lives.

We need to prepare our hearts and lives for Jesus our Saviour to be reborn in us during this Christmas time. We have to fill in the "valleys" of our souls, formed from our shallow prayer life and a minimalist living out of our Faith. We have to straighten whatever crooked paths we've been walking.
