Dear Parishioners,

I would like to thank you all for your support over the last year. Last year's parish accounts are on the back of this newsletter.

With Covid19 we all needed to manage our finances well. The Parish Finance is collected through weekly envelopes and Sunday contributions. Also, the Parish Draw and Tax Rebates came to €20,798 last year. These funds are vital in the running of the parish. If you recently received a letter re tax rebate, from the parish office, can you please sign and return in the stamp addressed provided. These letters are valid for 5 years, so you will only be asked to return one every 5 years. They enable the church to claim tax relief on any donation of €250+ in the year. Diocesan collections go directly to the Diocese.

The cameras have been very successful with a lot of people here and abroad linking into our Masses on <a href="https://www.milltownlistryparish.com">www.milltownlistryparish.com</a>. Boxes of envelopes go to over 450 houses each year and on average 60 a week come back. Please feel free to drop them in at any time to the parish office. Spring, Easter, Autumn, November, Christmas dues envelopes are in your yearly boxes and these dues along with Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms provide income for the priest. This winter will see an increase in heating and lighting bills. Together, let us keep our churches comfortable places for prayer and Eucharist.

Again, thank you for your continued support.
