Dear Parishioners,

You will find the parish financial report on the back of this weekend's newsletter. I would like to extend my gratitude to all of you for your contributions throughout the year. Your ongoing support is crucial for sustaining the work of the parish.

Your weekly envelope and offertory collections fund the parish's operating expenses, including insurance, utilities, wages, office supplies, and repairs. The Parish tax back scheme and our annual Parish draw are also essential for covering these costs. If you haven't yet returned your tax rebate form, which was sent to you earlier this year, please sign and return it in the provided stamped addressed envelope. These forms are issued every five years and allow the church to claim tax relief on donations of €250 or more made during the financial year. Each year, we distribute boxes of envelopes to 450 households. If you would like to participate in the envelope system, please contact the parish office.

The monthly Special Diocesan collections go directly to the Diocese of Kerry. The Christmas, Spring, Easter, and November offerings, along with funds from weddings, funerals, and baptisms, provide the priest's salary.

Thank you once again for your generosity, especially considering the financial demands of supporting your families.
