Light and darkness

Terry Anderson, a journalist for the Associated Press, was seized and held hostage in Lebanon for seven years; blindfolded almost all of that time, Anderson described his experience in this way, "Deepest darkness, fumbling, uncertainties are frightening. More frightening is the darkness of the mind, when outside light makes no impression and inner lights go dim. . ." [Den of Lions, Crown Publishers, Inc. (New York: 1993).]

In the Holy Scriptures, light and darkness serve as symbols for good and evil. In this Sunday's first reading and in the Gospel, Jesus is presented as the One sent to remove the darkness of sin from the world. Through Isaiah, God promises that His people will see an end to the darkness of oppression and separation. This Sunday's Gospel shows us how the prophecy of Isaiah was fulfilled in Jesus.
